HOLIDAY SECURITY TIPS

1. Don't Advertise on Social Media

Refrain from posting travel plans and pictures on social media sites, until after you return home.

2. Install an Alarm System

Install a <u>Bee-Safe smart alarm</u> which allows you to monitor your home while your away. Arm and disarm your system from a smart device or computer.

3. Use Security Signs Around Your Home

Make sure your Bee-Safe Security Yard Signs and Window decals are properly located to alert suspected thieves that it would be smart to avoid bothering with your property.

4. Use Automatic Timers

Use light timers to set both interior and exterior lights to turn on and off at various times throughout the night. Use appliance outlet timers to turn a tv or radio on throughout the day.

5. LOCK All Doors & Windows

Before you leave your home be sure to check that all windows and doors are locked and all window blinds/curtains are closed. Don't forget the second floor and basement windows!

6. Never Leave a Key Under a Rock or Doormat

The first place a criminal will look for a spare key is under a door mat or objects near the door. Any spare keys for your home should be properly secured in a <u>mounted lock box</u> that is out of sight.


7. Install a Smart Camera

<u>8. Mail</u>

Ask your post office to hold your mail and packages, if you know in advance have all online orders delivered to the post office.
